

## MIXiii – Poster Submission Guidelines

### 1. Deadline and submission:

Abstracts must be submitted by February 14th, 2026. No further changes will be accepted after that date.

All submissions must be made online on the abstract submission platform. Abstracts submitted in any other way will not be accepted. For any issues with the platform, please email [info@mdset.org](mailto:info@mdset.org).

### 2. Language

All documents must be submitted and presented in English.

It is the authors' responsibility to submit a correct abstract (grammatically and scientifically).

### 3. Abstract

Abstracts (max 250 words) shall include:Background, Methods, Results, Discussion

Abbreviations are strongly discouraged. In the case they are used, the first time an abbreviation appears, it should be placed in brackets following the full word or phrase.

### 4. Authors:

The presenting author must be clearly marked on the submission form. Please do provide up-to-date contact details, as those will be used for any communications related to the Conference and your presentation. Any changes in the presenter or their contact details must be communicated as soon as possible to MinDset by email to [info@mdset.org](mailto:info@mdset.org)

## 5. Judgment

A team appointed by MinDset shall judge the submitted abstracts and choose which ones will be accepted for the conference. Note that the amount of allocated slots is limited.

## 6. Poster

After receiving a positive answer from the committee, the participant will receive instructions on how to construct the poster. The participant should adhere to the guidelines and provide their poster in a timely manner.

## 7. Registration for the Conference

Poster and abstract presenters must register to the Conference by January 31st, 2026 selecting the applicable fee.

MinDset does not guarantee to presenters who register after the aforementioned date that their abstracts will be included in the Conference publications, including the Abstract book and the conference Program.

By submitting work to MinDset, all writers agree to free access and use of the material published in it with proper acknowledgement of authorship.
